EU Commission adopts draft amendment to include chlorpyrifos in the POPs Regulation

On 30 June 2026, the European Commission adopted a draft amendment to include chlorpyrifos in Annex I of the POPs Regulation. The next step is the formal publication of the amended regulation, which will enter into force on the 20th day following its publication and will be directly applicable in all Member States. The main content of the draft amendment is as follows:

It is proposed to add the following entry to Part A of Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021:

Substance	CAS No	EC No	Specific exemption on intermediate use or other specification
Chlorpyrifos	2921-88-2	220-864-4	For the purposes of this entry, Article 4(1), point (b), shall apply to concentrations of chlorpyrifos equal to or below 0,01 mg/kg (0,000001 % by weight) where they are present in substances, mixtures or articles.

In addition, the draft amendments for medium-chain chlorinated paraffins (MCCPs) and long-chain perfluorocarboxylic acids (LCPFCA), which were published on the same day as chlorpyrifos, are still under review and have not yet been adopted by the European Commission.
