TSCA restricts the use of five PBT substances

According to the requirements of Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), EPA issued five final rules on January 6, 2021 to reduce the impact on certain persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic chemicals (PBT) contact. The five final rules put forward restrictions on decabromodiphenyl ether (decaBDE), phenol, isopropylated phosphate(3:1) (PIP(3:1)), 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP), pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP), and hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD). These chemicals will accumulate in the environment over time and may therefore pose potential risks to the people who come into contact. The above rules will take effect on February 5, 2021, and will be implemented step by step on March 8.
